If You Are a Landlord

...and have a renter in your house in the water district, you should be aware that our bylaws allow us to serve only shareholders and property owners. Shareholders/Property Owners are the owners of record. As a courtesy, we can send a duplicate bill to your renter upon your written and signed request. The request form is available on this website. A new customer sign-up form must be filled out each time you get a new tenant. You will continue to receive a bill, which will help you monitor your tenant's usage and payment activity. Responsibility for payment remains the shareholder/Property Owner of record, if the tenant does not pay. Check with Wigwam before refunding your tenant's security deposit

General Information About Your Water Service

Any leaks which occur on the customer's side of the water meter are the customer's responsibility for both repairs and water loss. If Wigwam determines there is a leak on the customer's side, Wigwam will make an attempt to contact the customer. Failure by the customer to repair the leak immediately may result in termination of water service until such time the leak has been repaired.

Important Information About Selling Water and Theft

Water Theft costs everyone!! If you see suspicious activity or suspect water theft, please report it to the Sheriff's office in the county in which you live. Reselling water to a third party of the property for which it is intended is against rules and regulations. If a customer has been found to have sold water to a third party, the customer may be subject to a \$5,000 fine and/or termination of water service.
